 - Discussion on sufficiency rating ad Trans 213. Currently looking at updated interpretation of trans 213 to allow some flexibility to allow structures that have a sufficiency rating above 50 when replacement makes sense. Long term WisDOT and WCHA working to rewrite of Trans 213.
